Financial Status

The VGS's operating budget was primarily funded by profits from past symposia, technical short courses and conferences. As of September 20, 2015, the end of the VGS accounting year, the account balances were \$37,719.95, of which \$11,596.98 was invested in a business savings account at Tangerine Bank (formally ING Direct), with the remainder being used to fund regular operations. A brief report by the Treasurer is attached.

The Local Organizing Committee of the 69th Annual Canadian Geotechnical Conference, GeoVancouver 2016, approached the VGS for seed money. The VGS offered \$10,000 during the 2013-2014 year and provided another \$10,000 during the 2014-2015 year. This seed money and a share in profit, if any, from the conference, are to be returned to the VGS upon the conclusion of the conference, allocated in accordance with the memorandum of understanding signed between the VGS, CGS and GeoVancouver 2016 Local Organizing Committee.
